

Conditions agreement for: GEO 100 Optional Field Trip to Devil's Lake

- The Devil's Lake and Baraboo field trip is an optional (extra credit) part of GEO SCI 100.
- Your UWM account will be billed \$20.00 by the UWM Bursar's office, and you agree to pay this fee.
- The field trip ticket is NONREFUNDABLE and NONTRANSFERABLE.
- You will be required to show your student ID (or other photo ID) upon boarding the bus before the trip.
- UWM does NOT provide health insurance for students participating in educational field experiences. Therefore, each student should bring evidence of health insurance coverage with them on the field trip.
- All UWM rules and policies apply to off-campus educational experiences.
- Absolutely no alcohol, drugs or weapons are allowed.
- Lunch and beverage will not be provided by UWM.
- The trip will require hiking over moderately rolling to steep terrain. Some stops require the ability to hike moderate distances (up to 1 mile) along uneven paths or trails. Hiking or similar sturdy walking shoes are strongly recommended. Rain gear or other weather-appropriate clothes are also strongly recommended.
