

#### IV. Housing

What are the Housing options for the program? Single / Shared?

Comments: Students can choose shared or single rooms in Sandburg Halls or in an off-campus apartment.

What percentage of students choose each option?

Comments: The majority of exchange students choose shared rooms in Sandburg Halls because of the location on campus and it is easier than finding off-campus housing.

What are the additional costs for each option, if any?

Comments: Sandburg Halls includes a meal plan and off-campus does not.

Location of housing in relation to classes / program office?

Comments: Within walking distance of one another. Sandburg is located right by all classroom buildings and program office. Apartments are usually a few blocks away.

Comments: Yes, most places on and off campus have access to public transportation provided free via U-Pass
