

Marshall Scholarships

Marshall Scholarships finance young Americans of high ability to study for a degree in the United Kingdom. Up to 40 Scholars are selected each year to study either at graduate or occasionally undergraduate level at an UK institution in any field of study. The scheme allows the Scholars, who are the potential leaders, opinion-formers and decision-makers in their own country, to gain an understanding and appreciation of British values and the British way of life. It also establishes long-lasting ties between the peoples of Britain and the United States. Each scholarship is held for two years in any discipline leading to the granting of a British university degree. Candidates must be American citizens, apply within two years of graduating, and have a GPA of at least 3.7 (or A-). The deadline for applications is mid-October.

If you are a UWM student and a serious applicant for the Marshall Scholarship, you must seek institutional endorsement through the Center for International Education.
