This brand new program provides a hands-on learning experience on International Librarianship from the perspective of South Korean professionals. Through a series of lectures, students will learn about Korea's contribution to the areas of printing, archiving, organizing and preserving materials in libraries. Three Undergraduate or Graduate credits in Information Studies are available for this program. Lectures will be given by Korean experts, government officials, practitioners, and library and Information Science professors. For the last five days, students will participate in a conference of the International Federation of Library Associations and Institutions.
