THE COURSE: This course is an introduction to criminology. Therefore the student will be exposed to numerous topics that encompass criminological thought. The exams could be take home if necessary and would be announced one class meeting before the exam is scheduled. Each exam will count for 1/3 of the final grade and is not cumulative. Each exam will cover only one third of the course.
