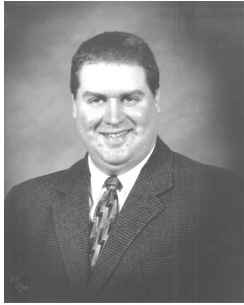

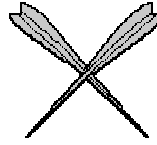
Dinner Club
